Sam Brownback, Kansas Governor


Sam Brownback was sworn in as governor of Kansas on January 9, 2011. Brownback served as Secretary of the Kansas Board of Agriculture from 1986 - 1993. During that time he also served as a White House Fellow in President George H. W. Bush's administration. In 1994, Kansans elected Brownback to the U.S. House of Representatives and,

two years later, to the U.S. Senate seat once held by former Senator Bob Dole. He was a founding member of the Senate Fiscal Watch Team.

As governor, Brownback is focused on growing the state's economy and increasing private sector jobs through improved regulations, controlled spending and lower tax rates. He has five measurable goals for his administration: Increase in net personal income; increase in private sector employment; increase in the percentage of 4th graders reading at grade level; increase in the percentage of high school graduates who are college or career ready; and decrease in the percentage of Kansas' children who live in poverty.

Garry Golden, Futurist/Foresight Strategist

Garry Golden is a professionally trained Futurist who speaks and consults on issues shaping business and society in the 21st Century. Mr. Golden's core focus addresses the role that current technologies will play in the future infrastructures of Transportation Systems and Energy as well



Garry is also an Adjunct Lecturer at the University of Houston where he teaches an online course on the Future of Energy & Environment. He received his Masters degree from the University of Houston Futures Studies program (M.S.) and is a past member on the Board of Directors of the Association of Professional Futurists (APF).

Jennifer Jo Cobb, NASCAR Race Car Driver

Jennifer Jo Cobb competes in 2 of NASCAR's top 3 series, the NASCAR Nationwide and NASCAR Camping World Truck Series. She is a unique racer not just because she is a female in this male dominated environment, but she also owns her team. There are very few owner/drivers and she is the only female owner/driver in the sport.

Jennifer began racing at the local ranks in her hometown of Kansas City in 1991. She pursued her racing dream for 19 years before landing an opportunity to race full-time at NASCAR's top levels. She currently holds the record for the highest finish by a woman in NASCAR at the famous Daytona International Speedway, with her 2011 6th place finish. She has raced at speeds well over 200mph and considers honing her business acumen just as important as her driving skills.

She is hoping her greatest legacy, however, is the success of her charitable organization, Driven2Honor, to honor America's military women.
